**Footh Cray Meadows is an area of parkland, meadows and woodland 97 hectares (240 acres) in size with the River Cray passing through it and is the largest open space in the Borough of Bexley.**

Noticeboards at the entrances to Footh Cray Meadows and notices around the lake at Five Arches Bridge specify activities which are not allowed. In the event you come across any of these being ignored we ask that you note time, date and where and depending on the incident or antisocial behaviour (see examples below) you inform the following: -

We have 2 members on the SNT panel and a pattern of offence could assist the Police to catch offenders.
